Prescribe to your patients

Patient-specific Rx, shipped to the patient.

For clinics prescribing patient-specific therapy to their patients.

503A is patient-specific compounding, filled per prescription and shipped directly to the patient. There are two ways to write it: your own licensed provider prescribes it, or a licensed provider in our telehealth network handles the visit and writes it for you.

The pharmacy is the merchant of record for the patient transaction. You keep the clinical relationship; we provide the supply rail and, if you want it, the prescriber network.

How it works.

1

Apply for an account

We verify your practice and connect you to the prescribing workflow.

2

Write or route the script

Your provider prescribes, or we route the patient through a licensed provider in our telehealth network.

3

Pharmacy ships to the patient

Patient-specific compound is filled per prescription and shipped to the patient; the pharmacy is merchant of record.

GET SET UP

Apply at uspeptiderx.com/start — two minutes; we verify your license and provision your account by hand, usually within one business day.

503A items are patient-specific compounded prescriptions dispensed per patient and require a valid prescription.

Compounded medications are not FDA-approved products and are dispensed only when a licensed provider determines it is appropriate.

503A is never represented as 503B office-stock.

Item availability varies by state and by pharmacy.
